Tuesday 9th October at Painswick Rugby Club

On Tuesday next week we have the first competitive sporting event of the year, which is a Football Festival for Years 5 and 6. As not all year 5 and 6 children wish to take part, we are also able to open this up to some Year 4 pupils who have indicated that they would like to compete, on the basis that they are part of a mixed age class and do taught sessions of P.E together.

The event is on Tuesday 9th October at Painswick Rugby Club and runs from 11.30 to 3.30. The children will play a series of 12 minute, 7 a side games against a range of other schools with roll on roll off substitutions, so we plan to take a full complement of 12 in the squad.

Mrs Barron and Debbie, Moji's nanny, are able to transport children to Painswick for 11.30 if you are agreeable to that on a 'parental favour' basis or you may prefer to drive your child to Painswick instead in which case they will need picking up at 11.15 to take to Painswick. Mr Tylour will be the teacher attending this event with your children for the rest of the day.

Children will need collecting from Painswick Rugby Club at 3.30 after the presentation ceremony, there is no after school club facility for these children on this day at Painswick. All children not in the squad of 12 will attend sport at Bentham, as usual with the rest of the school. If you need to fetch siblings early from Bentham in order to get to Painswick for 3.30 this will be fine, or there is after school sports club at Bentham until 4.15.

Children will need a packed lunch, water bottle and extra drink, coat, joggers or similar warm clothes as they will be outside for the duration of the festival.

School will provide each child with a brand new Sheepscombe School Sports Team Kit to wear. This consists of T shirt, shorts and football socks. Children will sign their numbered kit out with Mrs Powell. Each item in their kit is numbered and children will be responsible for bringing the kit with their allocated number on back to school, washed, folded and ready for next time. Mrs Powell will sign each kit back in. As this is new sports kit, any missing items will be charged for, Mrs Powell will issue an invoice for replacements, if this is necessary.

Pupils may wear football boots if they have them. Though this recommended, it is not essential. We would also suggest bringing a pair of trainers. If they have them, shin pads are also recommended. I have a pair of outgrown size 1 football boots going free of charge, if anyone would like them, please say.



Parents are welcome to attend any or this entire event. Parking is available in Painswick village Pay and Display car park or roadside in the town. There are 5 allocated parking spaces for Sheepscombe School at the rugby club and I therefore have 3 spare spaces as Mr Tylour and Debbie will take up one space each - if you would like one of these spare car passes please contact me. If you'd like to attend the whole event from 11.30 you'll get priority for the parking pass, after that it's first come, first served!
