Number: Rapid recall of number bonds. Place value to 100(y2) & 1000(y3), strategies for Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division – mentally and recorded. Counting on and back in steps of 2, 3, 5, and 10. Times tables rapid recall of 2s, 3s, 5s, 10s, 25s and 50s (Year 3's 4x table, 8x table)

Missing numbers, number sentence families...if I know ... then I also know....Adding 9 or 11 mentally using adding ten first to help me. Odd and even numbers, inverse operations

Shape space and measure: tell the time using analogue and digital clocks, measuring turns and simple angles, Roman numerals 1-12, measuring including perimeter

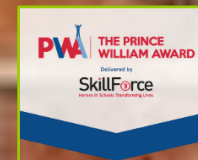
